Dear Sirs,

Lieut Fockley was killed about three and a half miles due east of Cachy and just north of Bois de Hanguard. He made an attack on the 30th U.S. and he was in charge of our left flank company. During the advance he was severely wounded and died where he fell very shortly afterwards. On being hit he refused to allow the stretcherbearers to touch him until some of his men who had fallen close ~~by~~ had received attention. He died where he fell game to the last.
